February 2017 Catfish Platter Trip

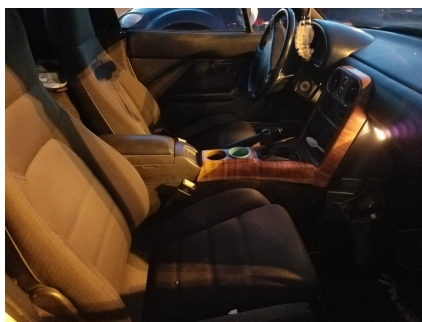

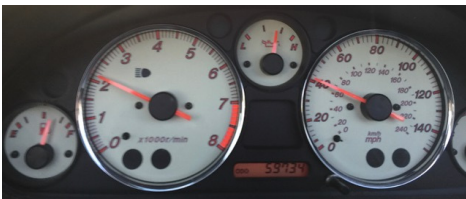

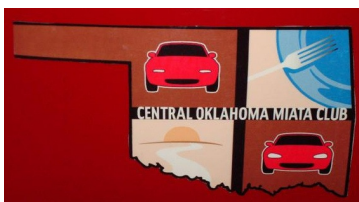
